

Bariloche, Argentina summer ski trip

August 11 - August 21 or 23, 2006

Ready to beat the South Florida Summer heat? Grab your snow skis and come join the Miami Ski Club on a magnificent trip to Bariloche, Argentina, South America. We will depart Miami International Airport on Friday evening, August 11th arriving in Buenos Aires on Saturday morning August 12th and onto a flight to Bariloche in Patagonia, Argentina. We will stay at the four star Club Hotel Catedral for seven nights with a daily breakfast buffet, three course dinner, health club, gym, and spa with massage, reiki, aromatherapy, Tai Chi classes, beauty salon and cosmetologist. Our hotel is slope side and we are going in high season which means an excellent time for great snow! Mount Catedral has fantastic views, surrounded by lakes and open views of the Andes and the volcanos of Chile. This year they opened some new lifts, have 50 trails, and over 300 ski instructors. The runs are 20% Beginner, 60% Intermediate and 20% Advanced. The quaint village of Bariloche is 15 kilometers away for shopping, restaurants, exploring and perhaps some nightlife. Take a day off to explore the Nahuel Huapi Lake area with picturesque views.



Saturday, August 19th we will return to Buenos Aires and stay at the five star Hotel Emperador, a short distance to the famous Recoleta district. Our return flight departs Sunday evening August 20th, arriving bright and early Monday morning, August 21st at Miami International Airport. There will be a two night extension option for those of us who require more time in Buenos Aires for sightseeing, the fabulous restaurants and shopping. NOVEMBER 3 - 19, 2006

This historical journey will first take us to Cairo, where we'll do our explorations from the world famous Mena House Hotel, a former palace with it's lush gardens and the pyramids for a back yard. We will start with Memphis, going about five thousand years back in time. Throughout the trip, we will move forward in time, forming a historical picture, which will bring so many events and places you have heard about into perspective.

After Cairo, it's off to Aswan, some site seeing, and to board the luxurious Royal Lotus for a four day cruise down the Nile. Stops will include the temple of Sobek and the Valley of the Kings, ending up in the unbelievable temples of Luxor and Karnak. From there, hop a jet to Aman, Jordan, to spend the night and off to Mt. Nebo, with its views of the fertile Jordan Valley, the Dead Sea and

Jericho. From there, visit Wadi Rum, the stomping grounds of Lawrence of Arabia, before reaching the monumental site of Petra. A full day of exploration there (you'll need it!), before leaving for Israel, and a day at a luxury spa on the Dead Sea. From there, we'll visit Masada, almost untouched since the days of the Jewish Zealots, with the Roman camps still clearly visible down below. On the way to Jerusalem, stop off to see the caves and settlement where the Dead Sea Scrolls were written, before fully immersing ourselves in biblical history. We'll be visiting sites that will make you taste and feel the events which took place in these parts, from the birth place of Jesus to churches erected in Crusader times. All this from the historical King David Hotel, right on the edge of the Old City.

In short - a truly epic journey everyone should make.
