RJ Diving Services, Miami Beach

Now that the water temperature has turned more agreeable, let's open up the dive season with one of Southeast Florida's best dive operation and boat, RJ Diving Services, on July 10, 2010 out of Miami Beach. This will be a good warm up to get ready for lobster season later in the month. We will meet at 8 AM at Miami Beach Marina, 300 Alton Rd., next to the Tarpoon Dive Center where the "Big Com-Ocean", a comfortable, custom built 46' Newton dive boat will pick us up. The boat leaves sharp at 8:30 AM. We plan to dive the Neptune Memorial and the North Emerald Reef, all easy dives, no deeper than 40 ft.

Any one needing tanks, please let me know. Air tanks are \$10 per tank and nitrox \$15 per tank. You will need to bring your C-Card. Nitrox certification is needed if you plan to rent nitrox tanks.
